
Wetlands and Water Features Study Guide (Test 9/8)

Water Features:

Bay- small body of water partly surrounded by land



Lake- large body of water that is <u>completely surrounded</u> by land.



River-flowing body of freshwater that always flows downstream




Estuary-Where the freshwater river

meets the larger body of water (gulf, etc) Salt water meets fresh



Delta-the mouth of a river. Fan or hand

shaped



Wetlands: (Land that is wet!)

Marsh (grasses)



Swamp (trees)

Bog (decaying plants & peat)






Salt

Climate

average weather over long time



Weather

temperature & precipitation at a particular time

Precipitation-rain, snow, sleet, hail



Adapt vs. Modify

Adapt-change behavior because of environment (We change ourselves)

Ex. wear light clothes when hot, eat seafood because of where we live, people fish or work in oil

Modify- to change something in our environment to fit our needs/wants (We change our surroundings) Ex. bridges, man made canals, levees, cutting forests, dams

Erosion- wind and water take away land from the shoreline/beach



Dams-built across rivers to control and even out the flow



Levees-barrier built along rivers to block water from escaping and flooding the surrounding area.
